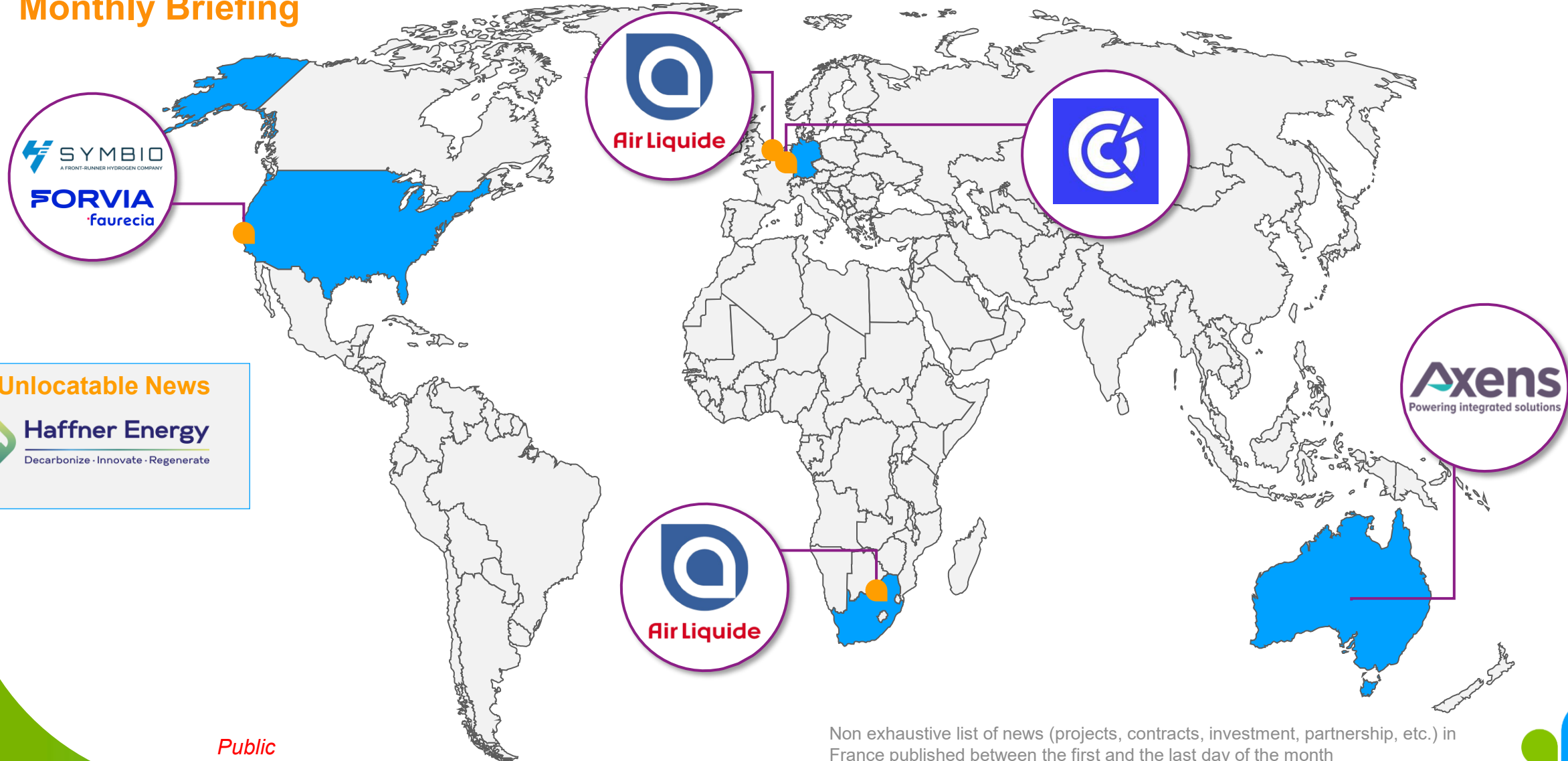

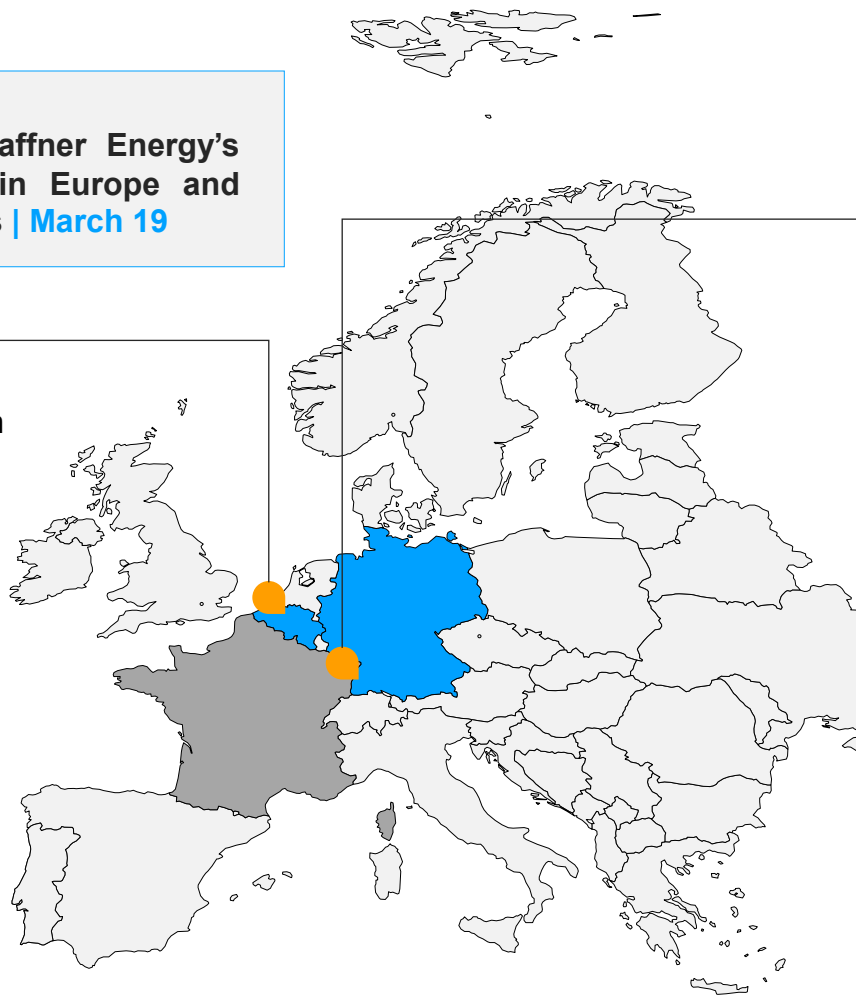

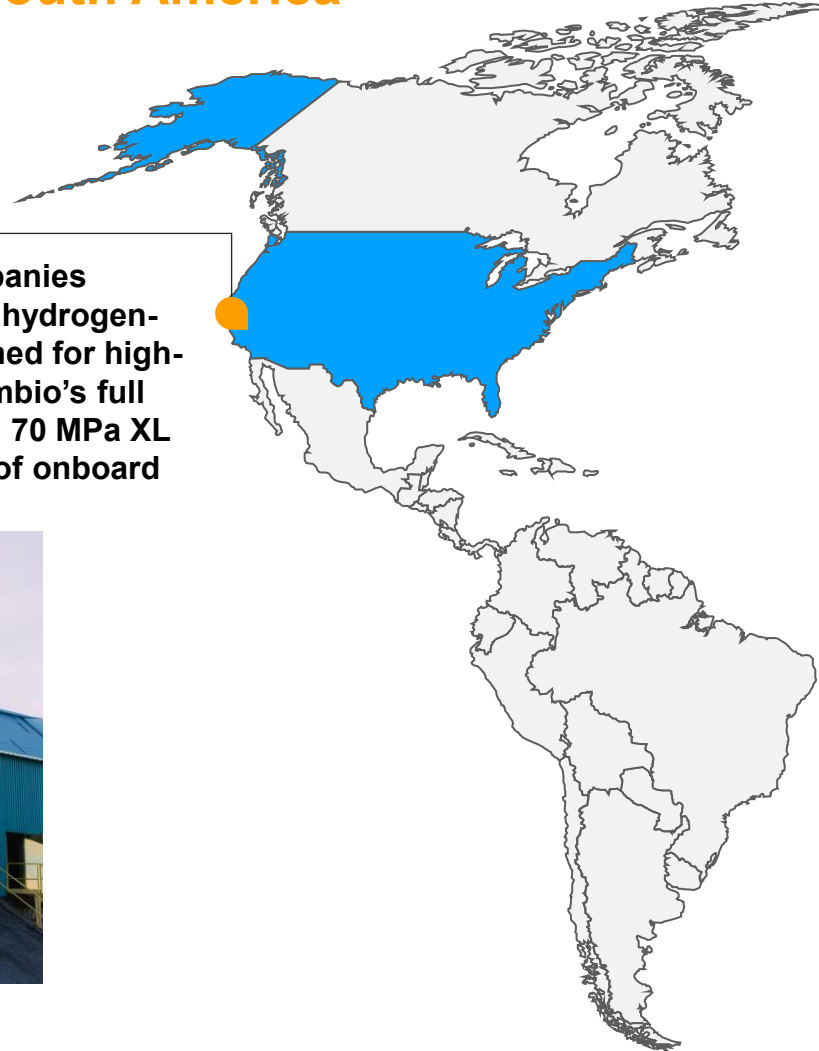

Johannesburg (South Africa)

Air Liquide South Africa, in partnership with the University of the Witwatersrand and the Localisation Support Fund, launches the start of construction of the Wits-South Africa Hydrogen Localisation Initiative to establish a modular hydrogen pilot plant on Wits University's West Campus. Due to be completed by 2028, the facility will utilize a 110kW electrolyser, with a storage capacity of 200kg, to serve as a collaboration between research and industry | March 3
