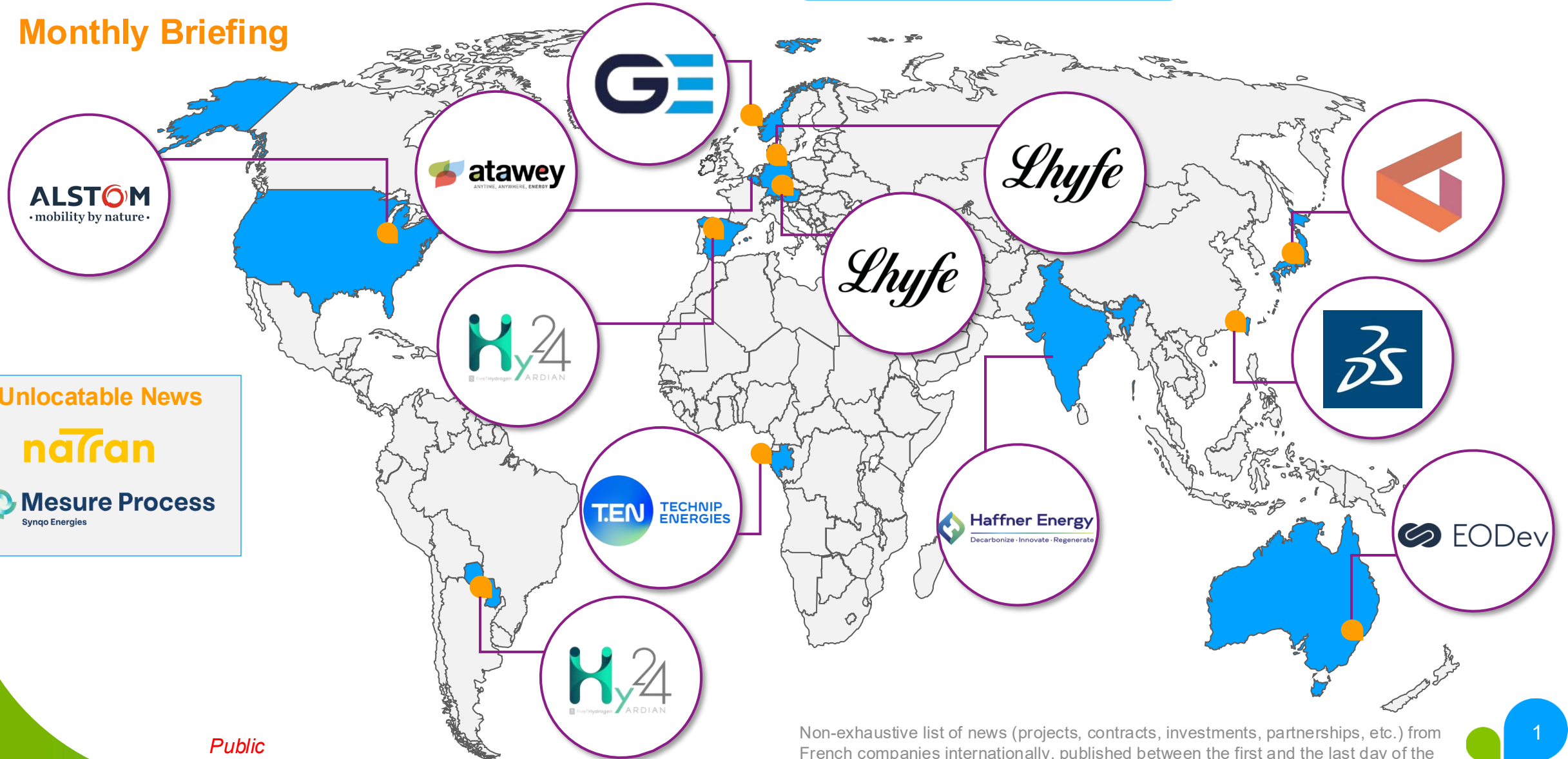

Unlocatable News



-The H2med project is officially renewed as an EU "Project of Common Interest", with the PCI label confirmed for the BarMar and CelZa interconnections, unlocking faster permitting and eligibility for European financial support under the CEF | [April 9](#)



-Synqo Energies (via subsidiary Mesure Process) places a ~€6M purchase order with Nel Hydrogen US for containerized PEM electrolyser equipment to supply hydrogen refueling stations and industrial uses at a site expected to be operational in 2027 | [April 17](#)

-Mesure Process awards Cavendish Hydrogen a ~€1.4M contract to deliver a renewable hydrogen fueling station in North-West Europe, serving industrial users and bus fleets under a Horizon Europe-funded initiative, with delivery scheduled for 2027 | [April 27](#)



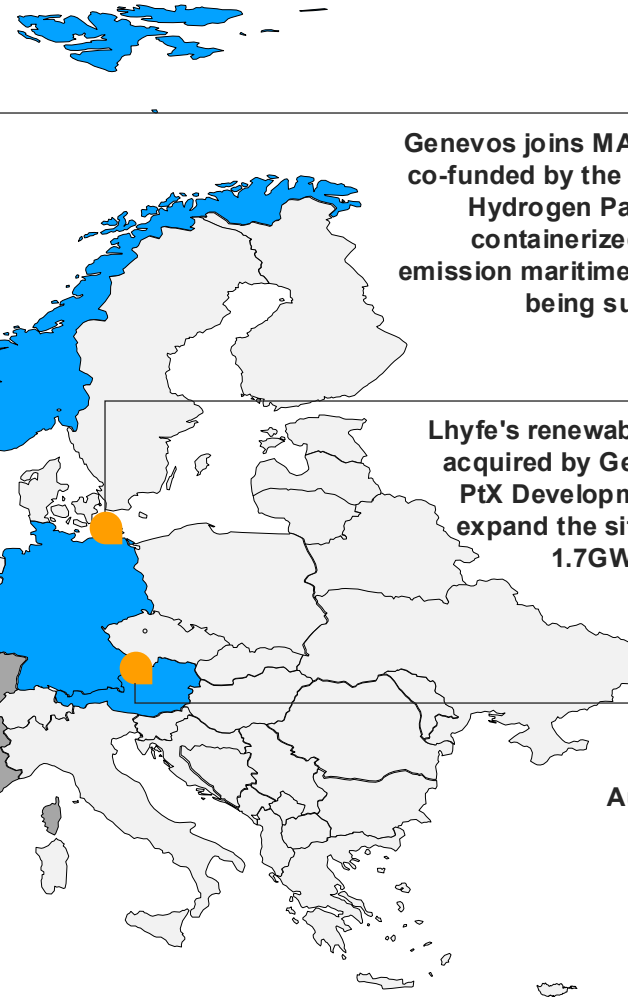
Belgium

Atawey announces the sale of three new hydrogen refueling stations dedicated to heavy-duty mobility, with a total distribution capacity exceeding 7 tonnes per day, to Colruyt Group and Virya Energy, to be deployed by the end of 2027 | [April 2](#)



Madrid (Spain)

Hy24 acquires a 40% stake in Enagás Renovable for €48m, thereby becoming the majority shareholder of the Spanish developer, which holds a portfolio of 850MW+ of more than 20 advanced renewable hydrogen and biomethane projects | [April 21](#)



Bergen (Norway)



Genevos joins MARINER-HE, a €7m Horizon Europe project co-funded by the European Commission through the Clean Hydrogen Partnership, to develop and validate a 1 MW containerized PEM hydrogen fuel cell system for zero-emission maritime applications, with Genevos' participation being supported by €2.2m in EU funding | [April 28](#)

Lubmin (Germany)



Lhyfe's renewable hydrogen project in Lubmin is partially acquired by German companies KGAL ESPF 6 Fund and PtX Development, which take a majority stake to jointly expand the site's potential production capacity to up to 1.7GW and 160kt of hydrogen per year | [April 15](#)

Steyr (Austria)



Lhyfe secures a multi-year contract with BMW Group to supply its Steyr site in Austria with renewable hydrogen, which will be used for the development, testing and validation of BMW's third-generation hydrogen fuel cell systems ahead of mass production from 2028 | [April 30](#)

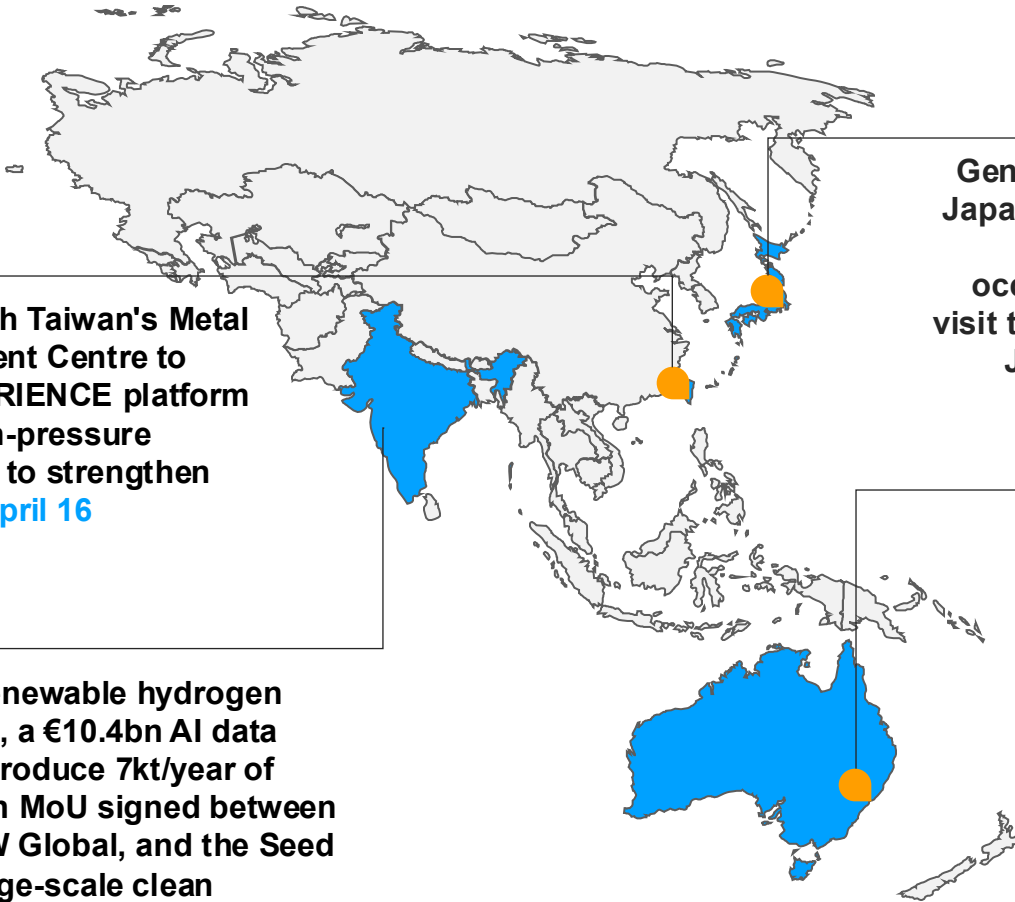
Kaoshiung (Taiwan)

Dassault Systèmes signs a MoU with Taiwan's Metal Industries Research and Development Centre to collaborate, via Dassault's 3DEXPERIENCE platform and virtual twin technology, on high-pressure hydrogen material analysis in order to strengthen Taiwan's hydrogen supply chain | [April 16](#)



Maharashtra (India)

Haffner Energy is selected as the renewable hydrogen technology partner for two projects, a €10.4bn AI data centre and a €280m plant that will produce 7kt/year of renewable hydrogen, within a €15bn MoU signed between the Government of Maharashtra, JW Global, and the Seed Consortium Partners to develop large-scale clean infrastructure in India | [April 21](#)



Tokyo (Japan)

Genvia signs a strategic agreement with Japanese firm HORIBA to accelerate low-carbon hydrogen solutions, on the occasion of French President Macron's visit to Japan aimed at advancing France-Japan industrial cooperation | [April 1](#)



Pitt Town (Australia)

EODev's GEH2 hydrogen fuel cell generator was deployed for two months to power the base camp of Netflix Australia's APEX movie, replacing diesel generators | [April 28](#)

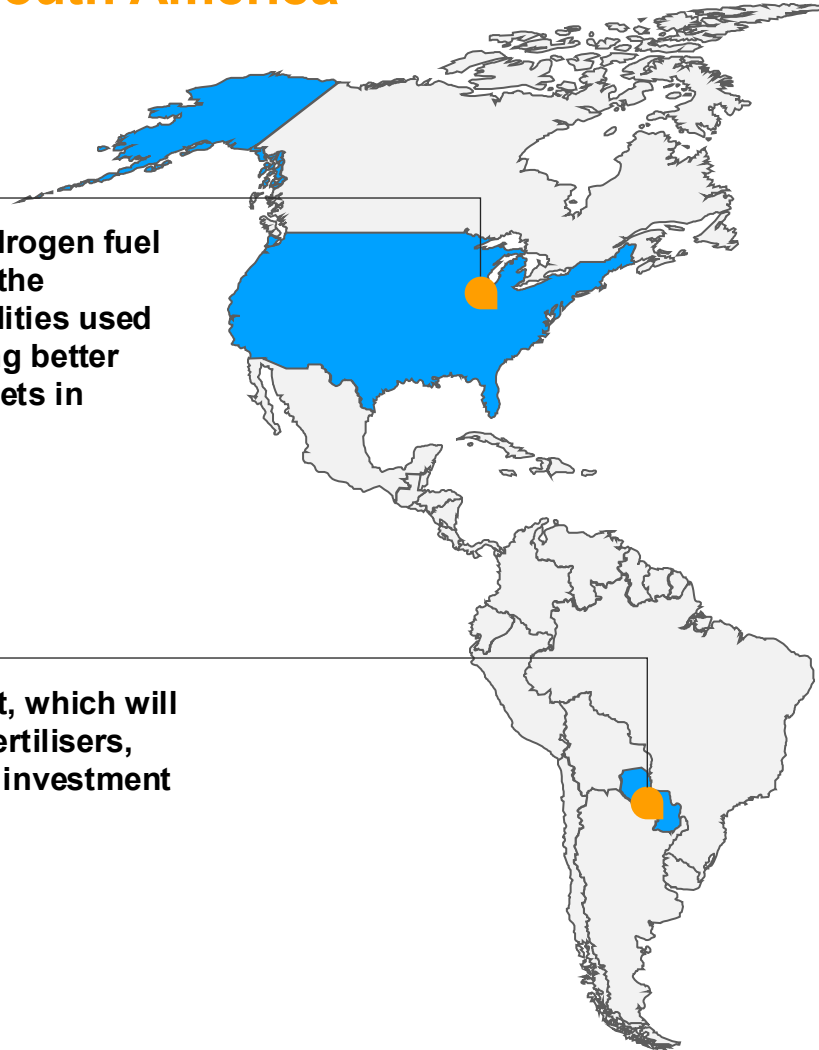
Columbus (United States of America)

Alstom acquires US-based Cummins' hydrogen fuel cell activities dedicated to rail, including the engineering, product and support capabilities used in Alstom's hydrogen train fleets, ensuring better support for its existing hydrogen train fleets in Germany, Italy, and France | [April 2](#)



Villeta (Paraguay)

Hy24-backed ATOME PLC's Villeta Project, which will produce up to 260kt/year of low-carbon fertilisers, reaches FID with a \$245m (€208m) equity investment led by Hy24 | [April 23](#)



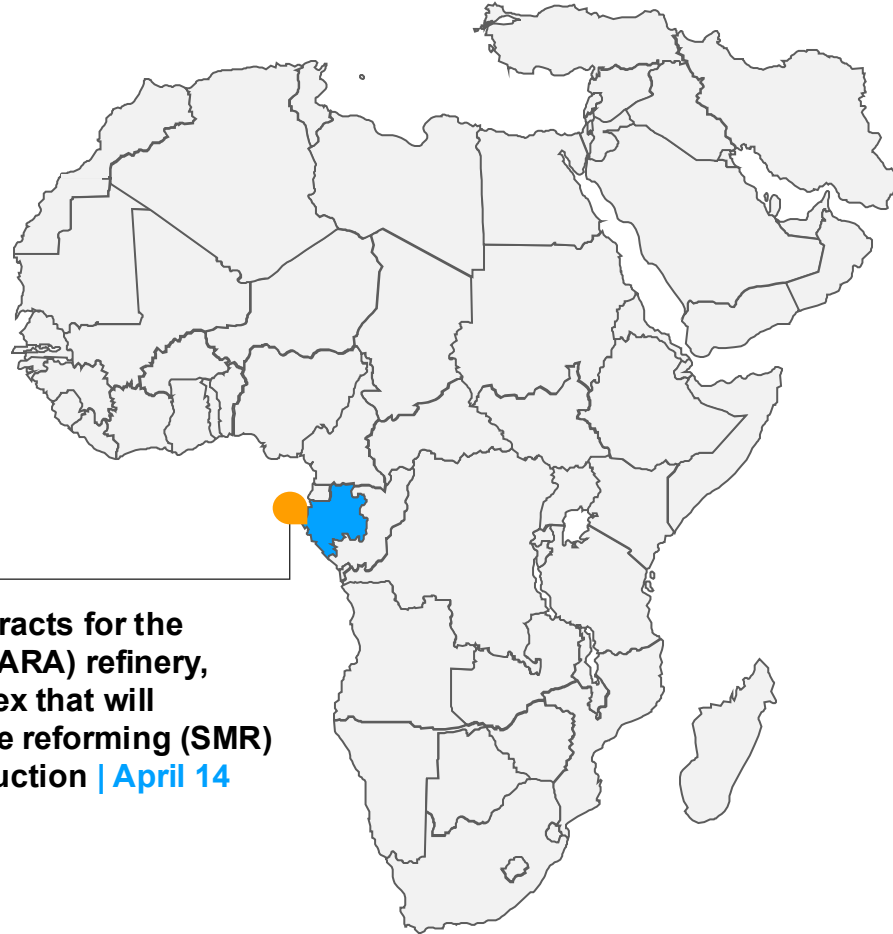
