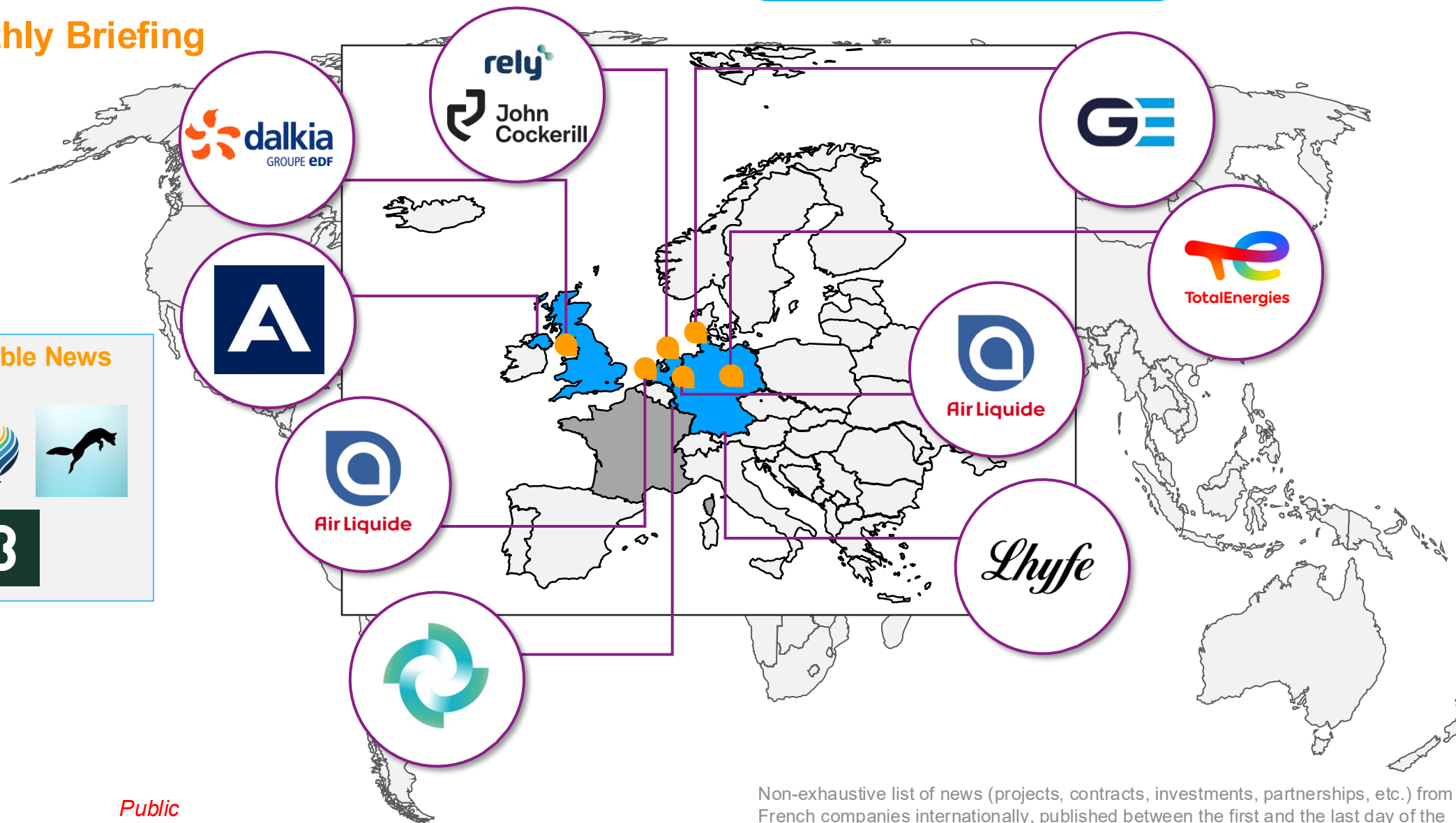

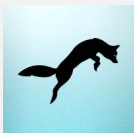

Delfzijl (Netherlands)



Rely, the joint venture between Technip Energies and John Cockerill, is appointed EPC contractor by Power2X, which announces having reached a Final Investment Decision for the 20 MW (2 kt/year) Djewels renewable hydrogen production project, with John Cockerill supplying its pressurized alkaline electrolysis technology | May 21



Barrow-in-Furness (United Kingdom)

Dalkia UK (EDF subsidiary) secures a construction contract from Carlton Power, which announces having reached a Final Investment Decision for the 30MW Barrow Green Hydrogen renewable hydrogen production project, which will supply Kimberly-Clark's manufacturing plant to cut its natural gas consumption by 50% | May 20



United Kingdom

Airbus takes the chair of the UK's Hydrogen in Aviation Alliance and announces alongside its members, including Bristol Airport, easyJet, GKN Aerospace, Rolls-Royce and newcomer Intelligent Energy, £188m (€217m) in combined R&D investment for hydrogen-powered aviation | May 19

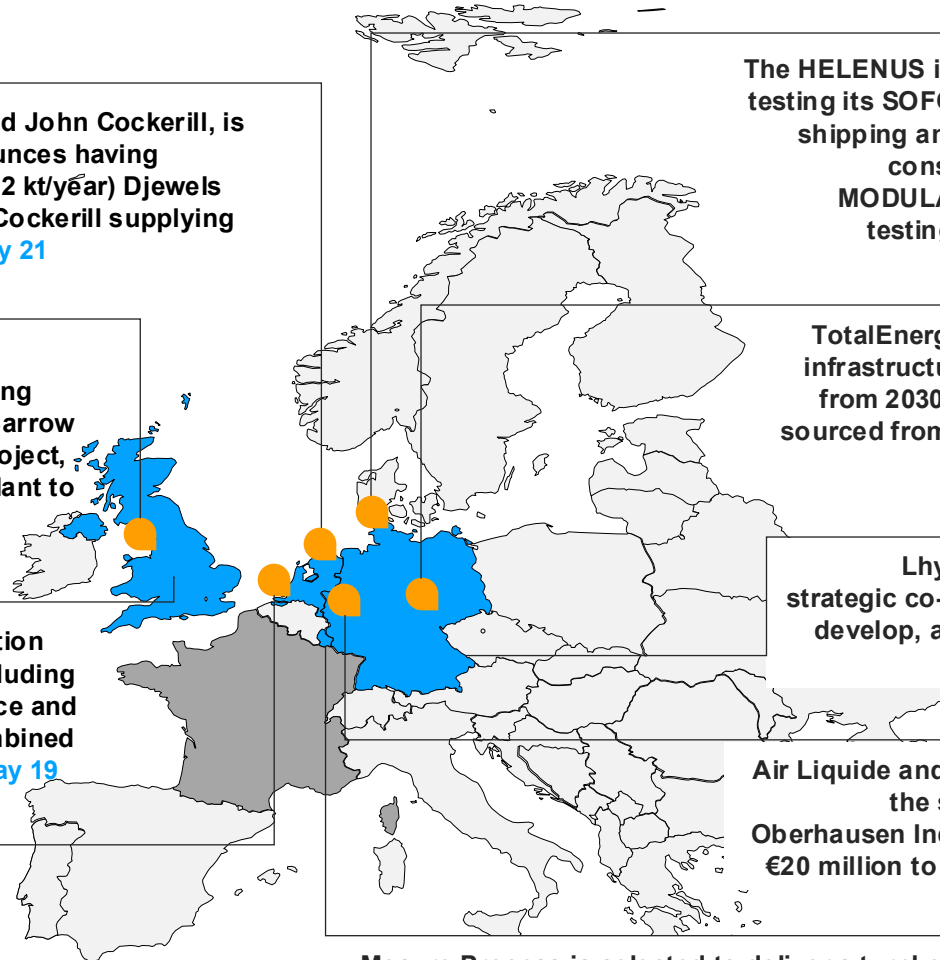

Rotterdam (Netherlands)

Air Liquide receives the delivery and installation of the first PEM electrolyser modules, produced by its joint venture with Siemens Energy, for its 200MW ELYgator project in the port of Rotterdam | May 27

Flensburg (Germany)

The HELENUS initiative, in which Genevos is taking part by testing its SOFC fuel-flexible power system for commercial shipping and cruise vessels, advances with the start of construction of the German Aerospace Center's MODULARIS floating laboratory which will serve for testing innovative maritime technologies | May 20



Leuna (Germany)

TotalEnergies reserves for its Leuna refinery a supply infrastructure of up to 15 tonnes of hydrogen per hour from 2030, via ONTRAS's hydrogen pipeline network, sourced from RWE's Lingen electrolyser project and the Bad Lauchstädt energy park | May 28



Germany

Lhyfe and Austrian company STRABAG sign a strategic co-development partnership to jointly identify, develop, and execute renewable hydrogen projects in Germany | May 28



Oberhausen (Germany)

Air Liquide and OXEA sign a 12-year contract extension for the supply of synthesis gas and hydrogen at the Oberhausen Industrial Park, with Air Liquide investing over €20 million to modernize its Partial Oxidation unit | May 18



Luxembourg

Mesure Process is selected to deliver a turnkey renewable hydrogen infrastructure for the LuxHyVal project, led by Enovos, covering 5 MW electrolysis production, 350-bar distribution for urban buses, with a target capacity of 2 t/day of hydrogen | May 12
